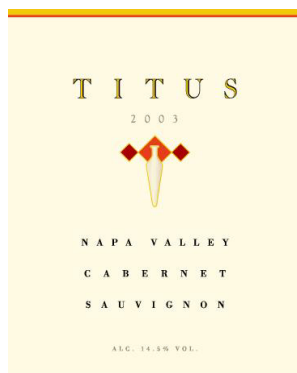

FAST FACTS

- Titus Vineyards is a 2nd generation family owned and operated wine business, land purchased in 1968
- Located amongst 40 acres of vineyards in the heart of the Napa Valley along the Silverado Trail just north of St. Helena
- Dynamic Duo: Eric Titus is the Vineyard Manager and Phillip Titus is the Winemaker
- First Vintage 1990
- Napa Valley wines are made almost entirely with Titus Vineyards' estate valley floor fruit (sometimes hillside fruit is sourced for panache)
- 6,000 case portfolio
- Red wine only producer
- Cabernet Sauvignon is the flagship wine
- Titus Vineyard personalities are leaders in the industry and community, Eric Titus is the current President of the Napa Valley Grape Growers Association

WINE SPEAK

- Robust wine style with lots of down home character
- Historic piece of Napa Valley floor making ultra-premium wines (vineyard dates back to 1880's)
- All our wines are blends. Our winemaking philosophy is 100% behind blending varieties to complete a wine. This style best expresses the primary grape variety, vineyard source, growing season and region.
- Grapes are de-stemmed but not crushed allowing for increased control over tannin extraction by minimizing the risk of broken skins and split seeds
- Juice undergoes 48 hour cold soak prior to fermentation
- Wines show consistent Vibrant colors and Vivacious flavor
