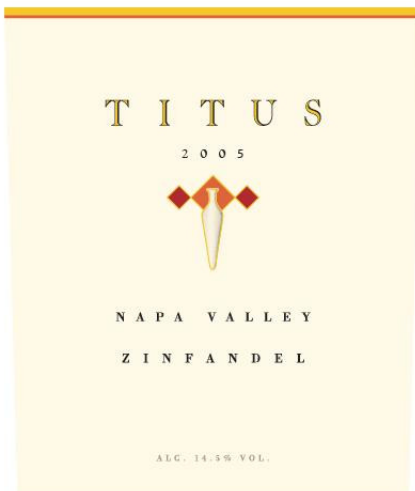

FAST FACTS

- Titus Vineyards is a 2nd generation family owned and operated wine business, land purchased in 1968
- Located amongst 40+ acres of valley floor vineyards in the heart of the Napa Valley along the Silverado Trail in St. Helena
- Dynamic Duo: Eric Titus is the Vineyard Manager and Phillip Titus is the Winemaker
- All our wines are blends. Our winemaking philosophy is 100% behind blending varieties to complete a wine that best represents the primary variety, vineyard, region and growing season.

- Napa Valley wines are made almost entirely with Titus Vineyards' estate valley floor fruit (sometimes hillside fruit is sourced for panache)

2005 Napa Valley Zinfandel



The Napa Valley Zinfandel is our Heritage wine because Zinfandel was one of the original grapevine plantings on our historic, 1880's, Napa Valley vineyard. These are the oldest vines on the Titus property (about 35 years old). The Zin is Eric's favorite because he feels the wine is a true varietal expression that is the most representative of the Titus vineyard characteristics, the land he has known since childhood.

The zinfandel grapes are grown from our estate dry-farmed vines, an Old World farming practice that helps the vines to focus on producing fewer clusters of intensely flavored grapes.

The Napa Valley Zinfandel is a traditional, rustic style Zin with a ripe, juicy red fruit core encased with black pepper spice. It is well balanced without the Port-like characters so common today in many Zinfandels because of the splash of Petite Sirah that's blended into the wine bolstering the wine's color, fruit forwardness, and spice (versus high alcohol associated aromas and tastes).
